

Website Terms of Use

These Website Terms of Use set out the terms under which you may use this website, www.kateparslow.com ("our Site"). Please read these Website Terms of Use carefully and ensure that you understand them. It will be deemed that you agree to comply with and be bound by these Website Terms of Use upon your first use of our Site. If you do not agree to comply with and be bound by these Website Terms of Use, you must stop using our Site immediately.

You must be over 18 years of age to use our e-design service or to order other services or products via our Site.

1. Definitions and Interpretation

1.1 In these Website Terms of Use, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the following meanings:

"Content" means any and all text, images, audio, video, scripts, code, software, databases and any other form of information capable of being stored on a computer that appears on, or forms part of, our Site; and

"We/Us/Our" means Kate Parslow Interior Design.

2. Access to Our Site

1.1 It is your responsibility to make any and all arrangements necessary in order to access our Site.

1.2 Access to our Site is free of charge. Access is provided "as is" and on an "as available" basis. We may alter, suspend or discontinue our Site (or any part of it) at any time and without notice. 3. Intellectual Property Rights

1.2 Subject to clause 3.3, you may not reproduce, copy, distribute, sell, rent, sub-licence, store, or in any other manner re-use Content from our Site unless we give you express written permission to do so.

1.3 You may:

3.a.1 Access, view and use our Site in a web browser (including any web browsing capability built into other types of software or app);

3.a.2 Download our Site (or any part of it) for caching;

3.a.3 Print pages from our Site;

3.a.4 Download extracts from pages on our Site; and

3.a.5 Save pages from our Site for later and/or offline viewing.

1.4 You must always acknowledge our status as the owner and author of the Content on our Site (or that of identified licensors, as appropriate).

1.5 You may not use any Content saved or downloaded from our Site for commercial purposes without first obtaining a licence from us (or our licensors, as appropriate) to do so. 3.a.6 is intended or is otherwise likely to infringe (or to threaten to infringe) another person's privacy;

3.a.7 misleadingly impersonates any person or otherwise misrepresents the identity or affiliation of a particular person in a way that is calculated to deceive;

3.a.8 infringes, or assists in the infringement of, the intellectual property rights (including, but not limited to, copyright, trademarks and database rights) of any other party; or

3.a.9 is made in breach of any legal duty owed to a third party including, but not limited to, contractual duties and duties of confidence.

1.4 The restrictions in clause 4.3 do not apply to content submitted to sites by other users, provided that the primary purpose of the site meets with the provisions of clause 4.3. You are not, for example, prohibited from posting links on general-purpose social networking sites merely because another user may post such content. - 2.a.6 any other actions which we deem reasonably appropriate (and lawful).
